**Please Note:** Archaeological Research Collections (ARC) staff will do the final boxing of collections at the Museum, and the curation fees will be based on the number and size of ARC standard-size containers filled. When estimating the curation fees for a collection, please remember that ARC staff separates artifacts and samples into containers by site, and divides site collections by material type, separating organic from inorganic materials. Organic/perishable items are housed separately from inorganic items, and therefore, may generate additional containers.

**The fees quoted above assume that the submitted collections are prepared in accordance with the ARC Procedures Manual for Submission of Collections.** Additional fees will be charged if Museum staff must process the collection to current standards.
